Ensure to clarify my responsibilities as agent, broker or principal to those I (we) conduct business.

Encourage other members to make the fair and equitable treatment of all the general public, clients and/or customers a primary concern.

Strive to make their professional affiliations and businesses profitable in monetary terms and through the support and encouragement of effective professional practices.

Instill in their employees and the public a sense of confidence about the conduct and intentions of their professional and business efforts.

Maintain loyalty to their (my) professional relationships, clients and customers while seeking profitability as I (we) pursue commerce related objectives in ways that are consistent with the public interest.

Uphold all laws and regulations relating to my professional and business activities.

Refrain from using my official positions, either regular or volunteer, to secure special privilege, gain or benefit for myself.
